**Description of Event:** Skip the pressure of a show and come school with feedback instead! Join us for a Dressage Fix-a-Test and/or Fix-a-Round day at Greenhill Park Equestrian Center.

**How it Works:** Sign up for a Fix-a-Test with the test of your choosing or Fix-a-Round at the height/level of your choice, or **BOTH!!** If you choose both, we will schedule your dressage test first and your jumping after. We will work in the small dressage arena first for USEA/Eventing Tests and USDF Intro Tests and then move to the large arena for all other tests. Amount of entries will determine if jumping will go high to low or low to high. Cross Country Schooling FREE for Greenhill Park Members, and \$25 for Non-Greenhill Park Members

**Entry Submission:** Entries are available online only. A software system will forward all entries to secretary. NO PAPER ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED. *Entries must include Entry Form, USEA Release, payment & a Current Negative Coggins test (within 12 months of show date) by the closing date.* Incomplete entries will be placed on a waiting list until all paperwork is received – no ride time will be assigned until all paperwork rec'd. *Late entries MAY be accepted and a \$10 late fee charged, at the Show Secretary's discretion.* Scratches prior to closing date will receive a full refund less a \$10 office fee. **After closing date, NO refunds will be given.** Entries may have to sign additional liability waivers the day of the show.

**Directions to GHPEC:** 2961 Harborwood Road, Salem, VA, 24153

Exit 137 off I-81. Turn towards Salem on Wildwood Road. At intersection with Route 11/460, turn right. Go through two lights. At third light, turn left onto Duiduids Lane. Cross RR tracks and pass first entrance to Green Hill Park. Go another mile to the Equestrian Center trailer entrance on your right. There is separate entrance for vehicles not pulling a trailer further down the road.

**Other information:** Starting times will be emailed to competitors and available by online on the Thursday before the show. Times will also be posted on [www.breventing.org](http://www.breventing.org). All riders, competing or non-competing, at all times on the competition grounds must wear a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The headgear and harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Anyone schooling cross country shall wear a cross country vest. A armbands are encouraged but not required. All dogs MUST be leashed. Owners of impounded dogs will be fined \$35. Dress is casual, but neat and tidy. Half chaps are allowed. USEF rules will be followed unless otherwise noted by show management.
